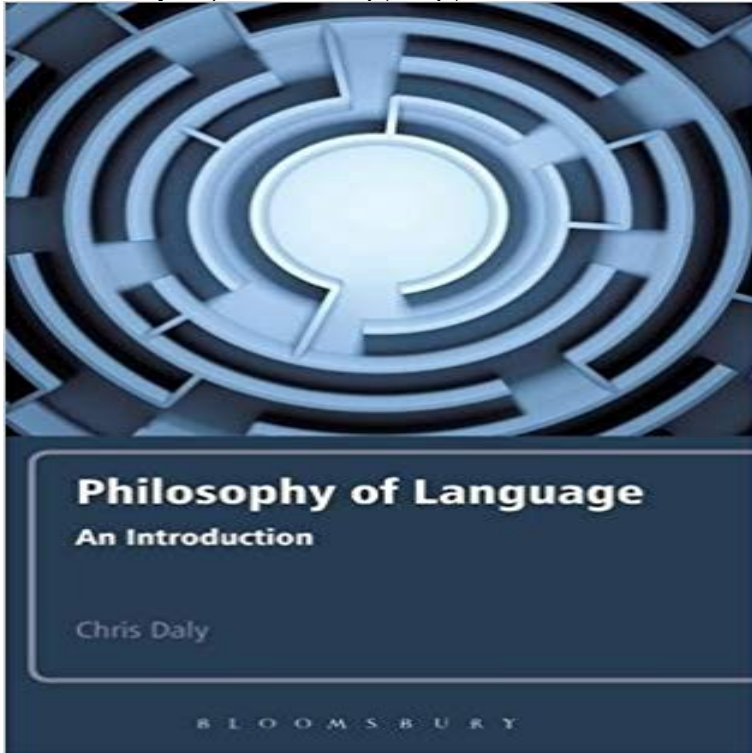


# Philosophy of Language: An Introduction
