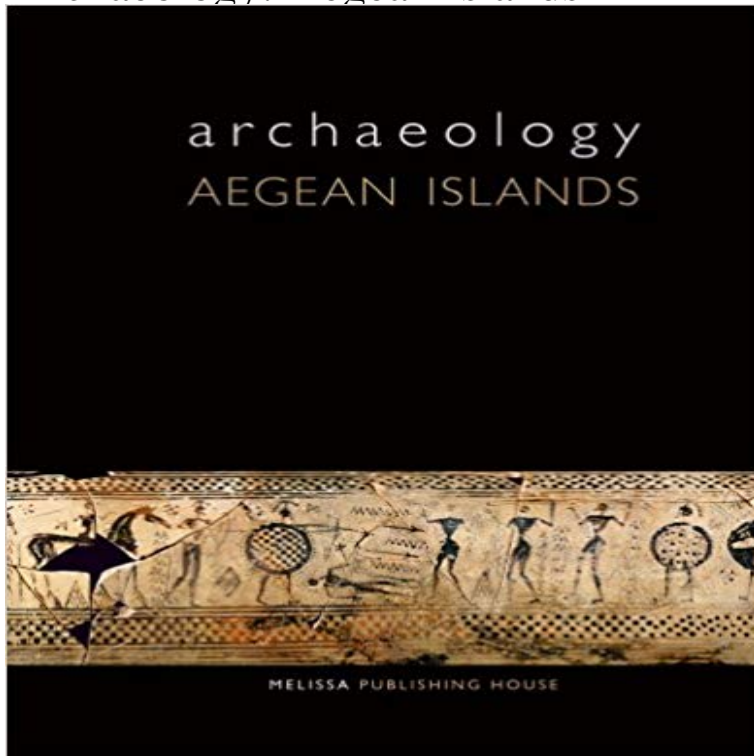


Archaeology: Aegean Islands
