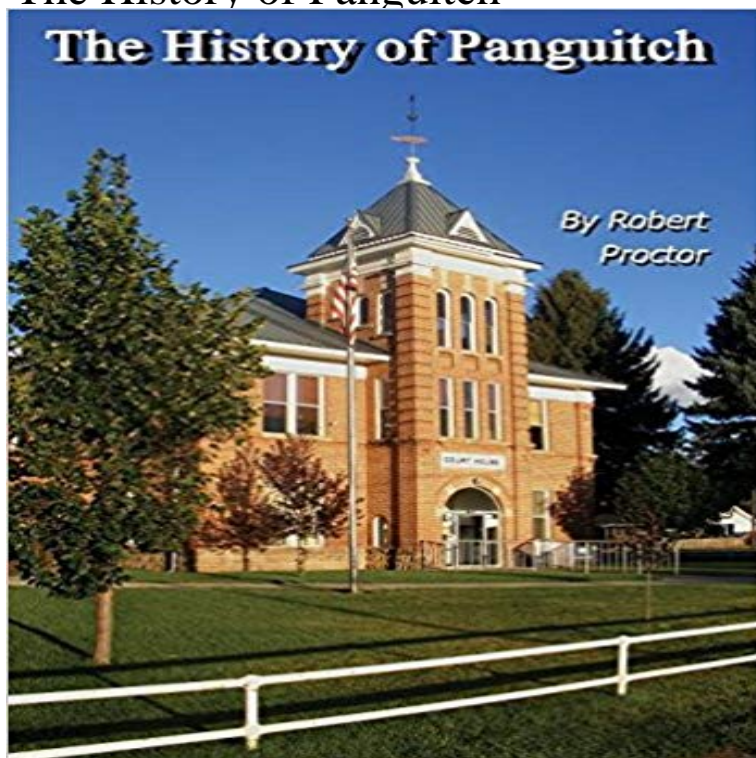


The History of Panguitch
