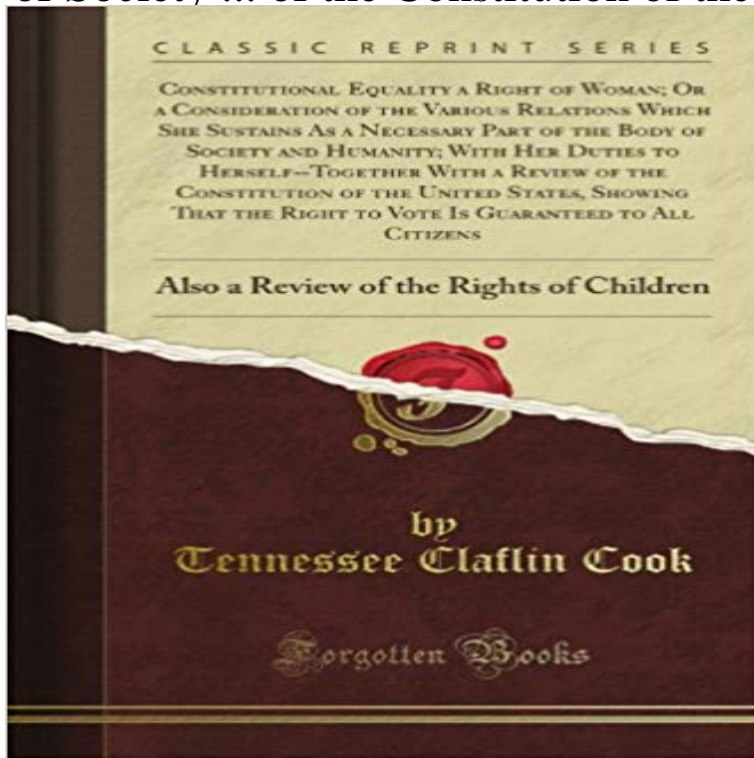

We feel that we are in duty bound to advocate the perfect equality of all human beings, which may, without assumption, be called the cause of humanity. We know there is a great amount of prejudice against women voting, in both sexes; but we also know that it is simply prejudice the same prejudice which all new developments of thought and science are always met by and that it only requires to be met by a persistent presentation of the realities of the question to in time divest the people of it. Our purpose in the construction of this book, in the beginning, development and ending, will be apparent to all who peruse it entire, and we make no apology for any seeming inconsistencies or seeming change of argument. But this we will say: The basis of all true humanitarian reform or rather growth lies in the coming generation. With the present little can be done; with the future everything.
