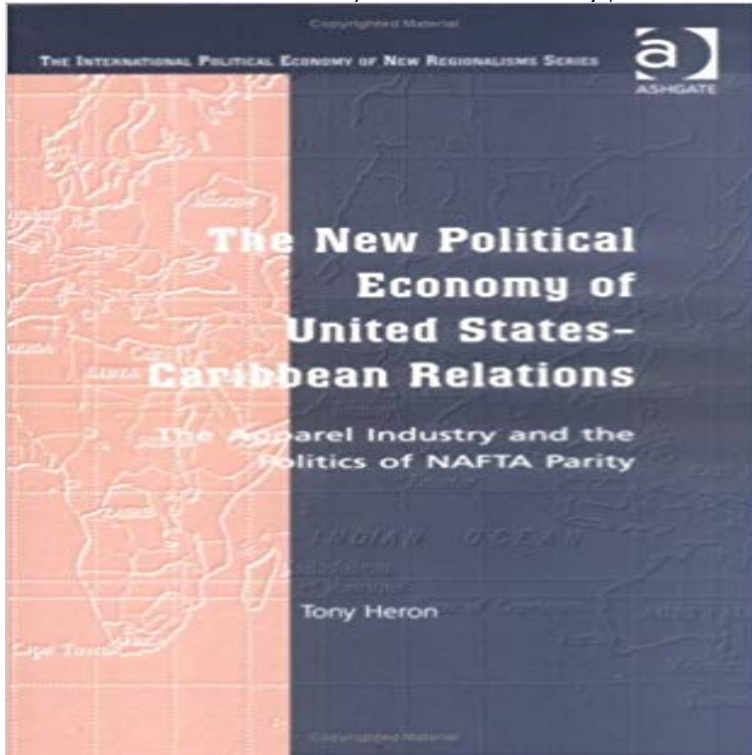


The New Political Economy of United States-Caribbean Relations: The Apparel Industry and the Politics of NAFTA Parity (The International Political Economy of New Regionalisms)
