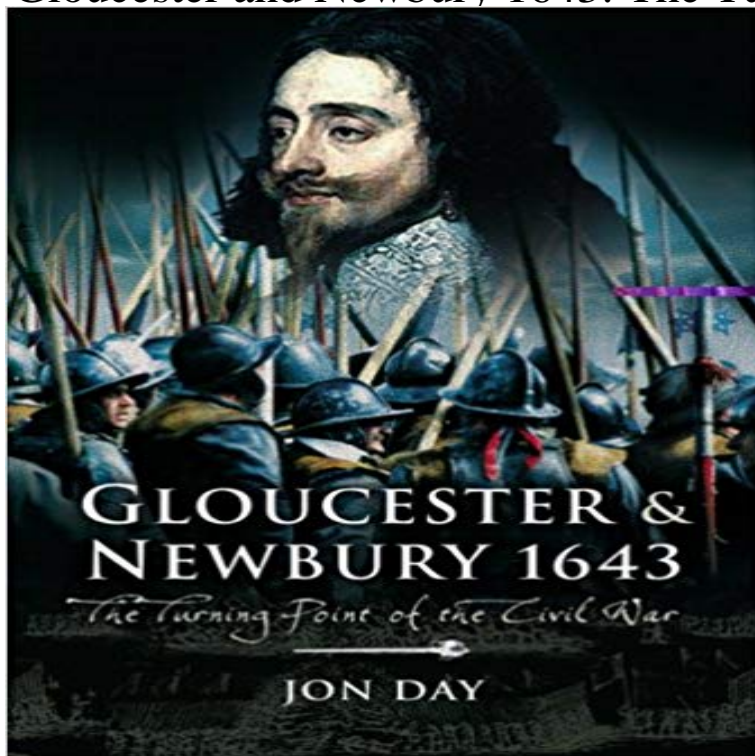


Gloucester and Newbury 1643: The Turning Point of the Civil War
