

Five weeks after the outbreak of the war the governments of Great Britain, France, and Russia declared; The British, French, and Russian Governments mutually engage not to conclude peace separately during the present war. The three governments agree that when terms of peace come to be discussed no one of the Allies will demand terms of peace without the previous agreement of each of the other Allies. Later this treaty was agreed to by Japan and Serbia. After this formal treaty was signed the Prime Ministers in Great Britain and in France declared their governments attitude. Mr. Asquith in a speech at the Guildhall, London, November 9, 1914, stated more explicitly than he had yet done the following; Attitude of the Allies.
