

The characters of the assailants, the forces and interests back of them, the nature of the assault, and the defenders of representative government, are all described. There are four episodes to this story: The suspension; the reaction of the country and of the world to the suspension; the trial, and the expulsion. The suspension took place on January 7, 1920. The trial began January 20 and ended March 11. The expulsion took place March 31, 1920. Between January 7 and March 31 enough had happened to fill many, many volumes.
