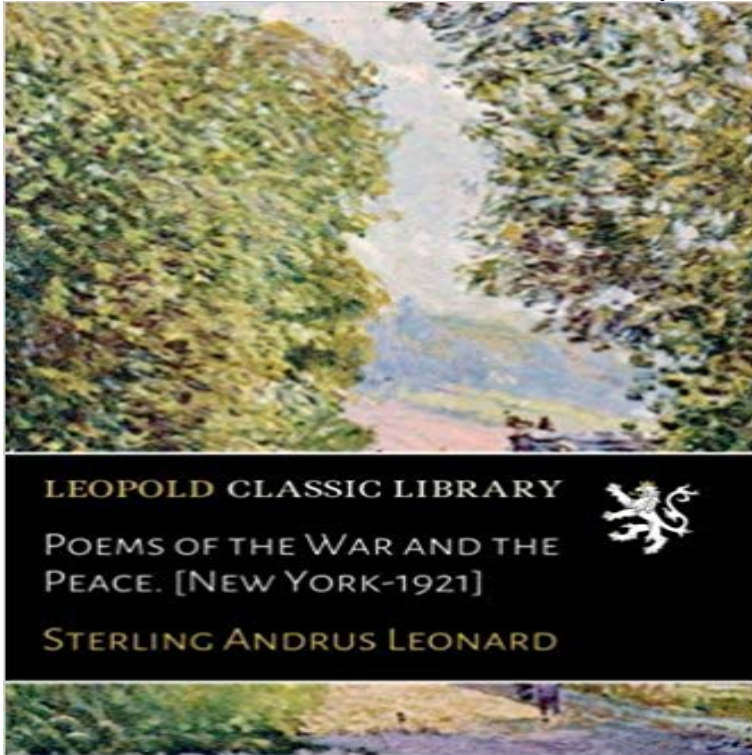


## Poems of the War and the Peace. [New York-1921]
