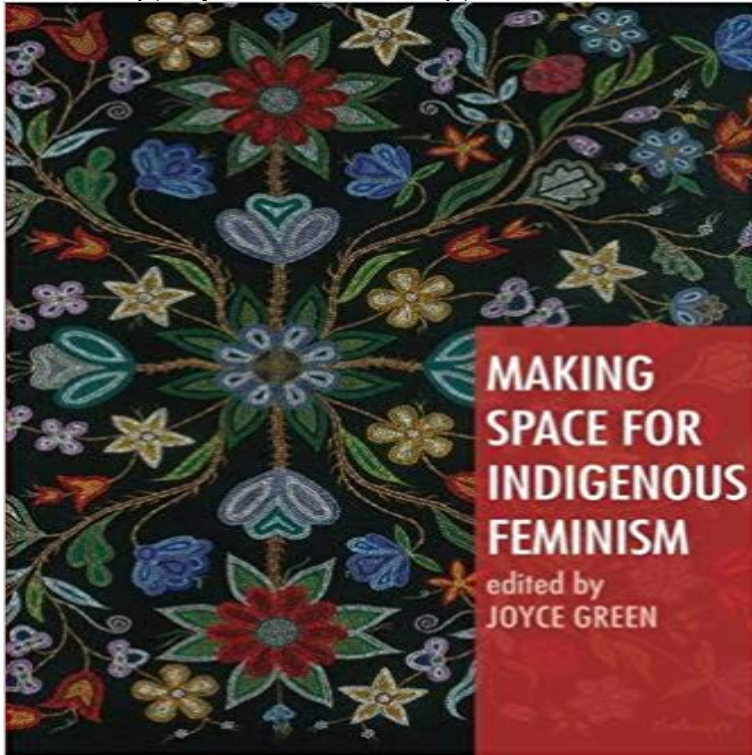


Making Space for Indigenous Feminism
