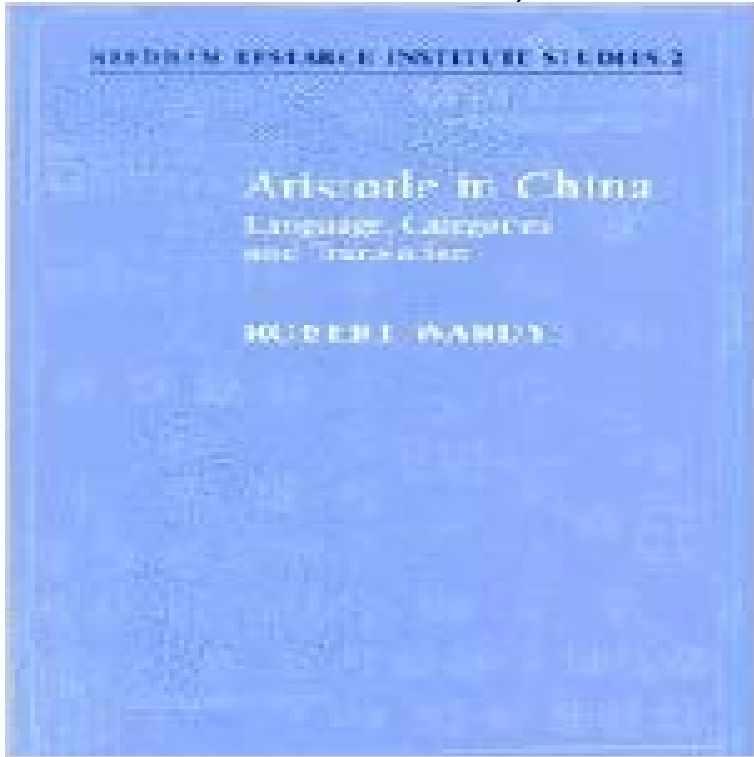


Aristotle in China: Language, Categories and Translation (Needham Research Institute Studies)
