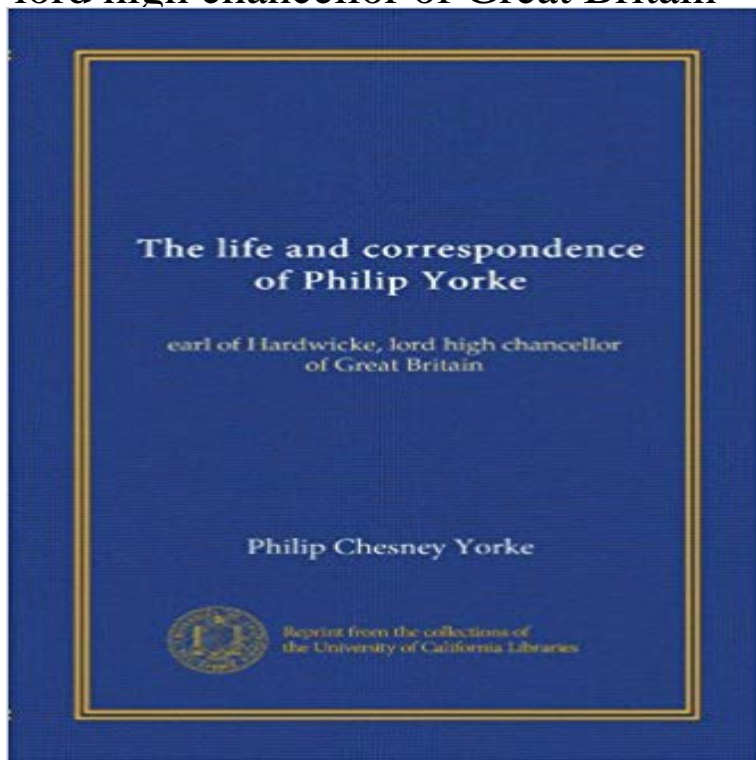


The life and correspondence of Philip Yorke (v.2): earl of Hardwicke, lord high chancellor of Great Britain
