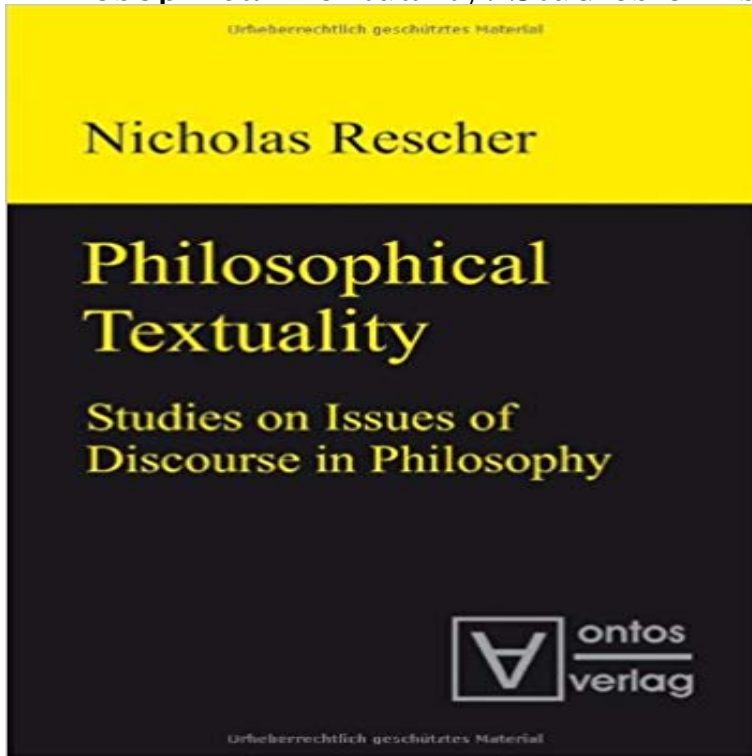


# Philosophical Textuality: Studies on Issues of Discourse in Philosophy
