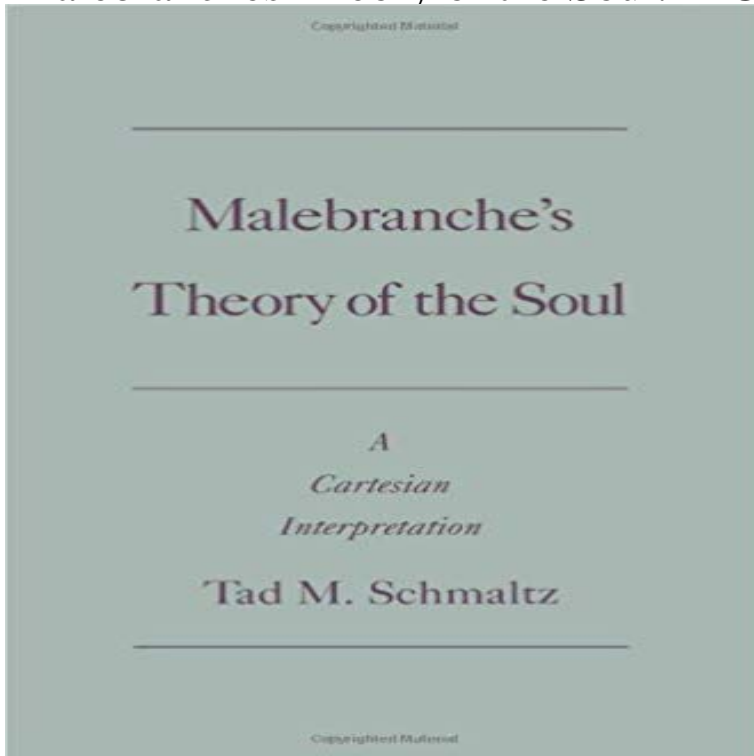


# Malebranches Theory of the Soul: A Cartesian Interpretation
