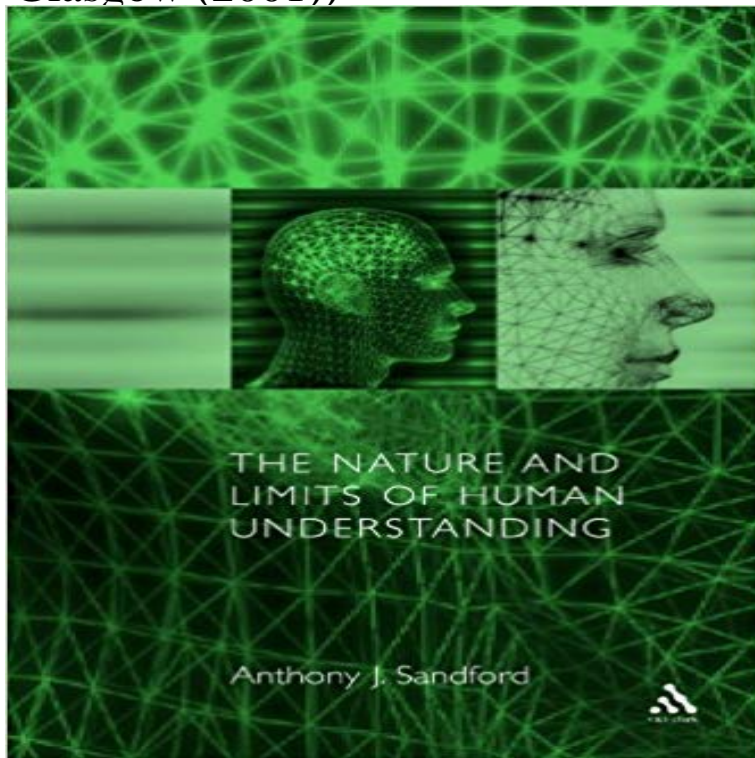


The Nature and Limits of Human Understanding (Gifford Lectures Glasgow (2001))
