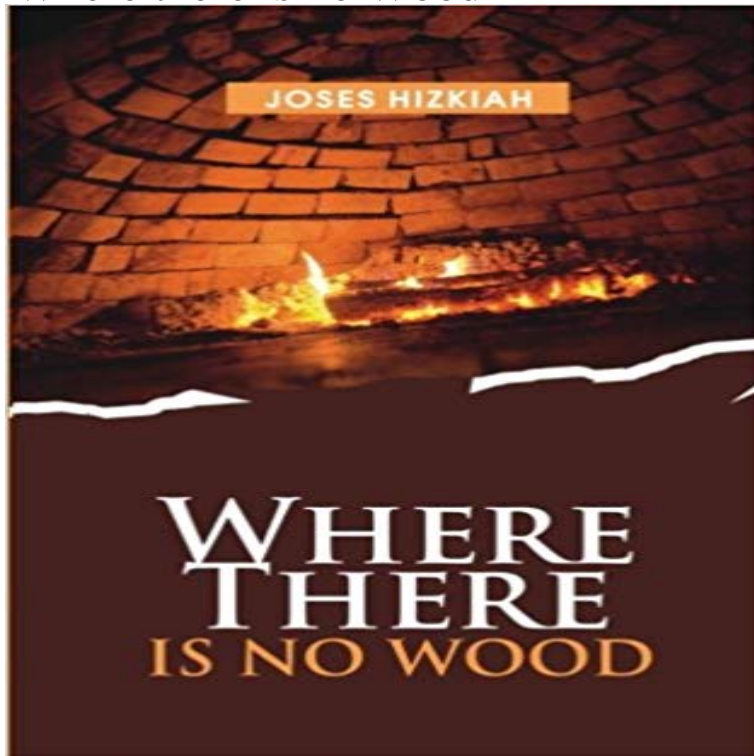


## Where there is no Wood
