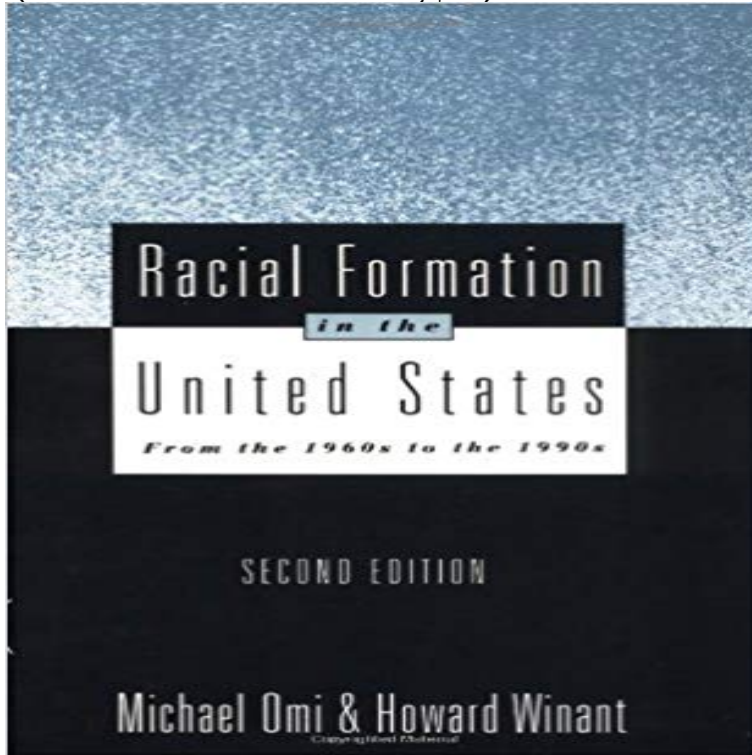


Racial Formation in the United States: From the 1960s to the 1990s (Critical Social Thought)
