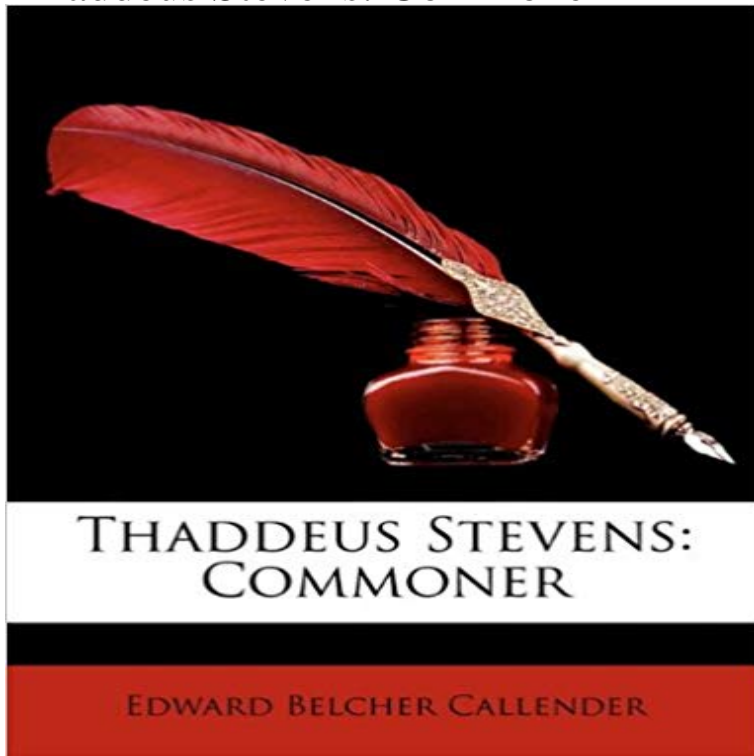


Thaddeus Stevens: Commoner
