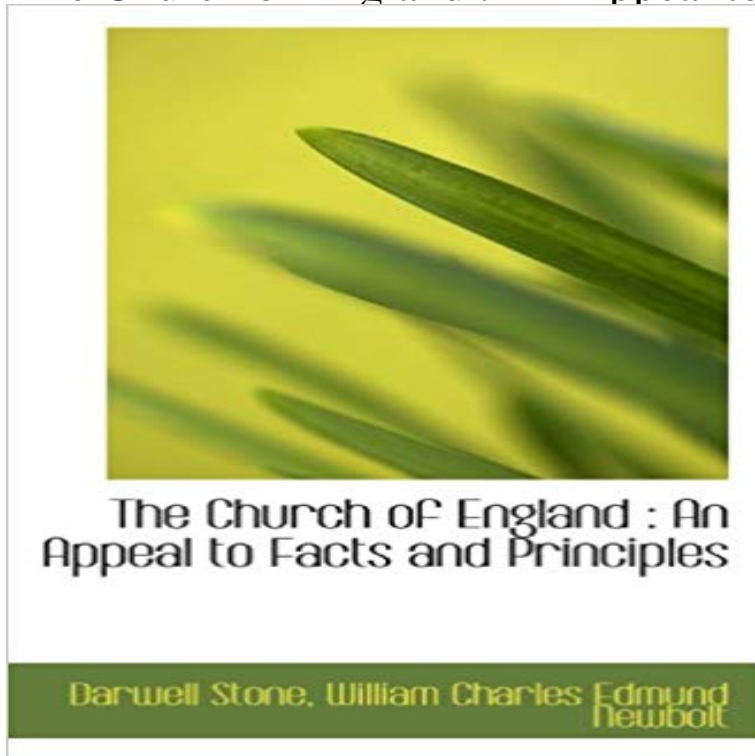


# The Church of England : An Appeal to Facts and Principles
