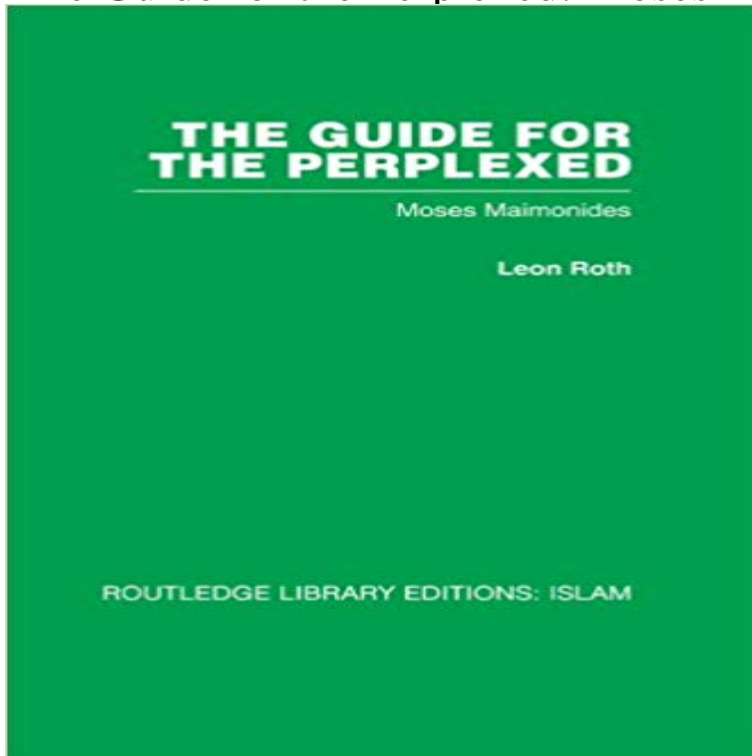


The Guide for the Perplexed: Moses Maimonides
