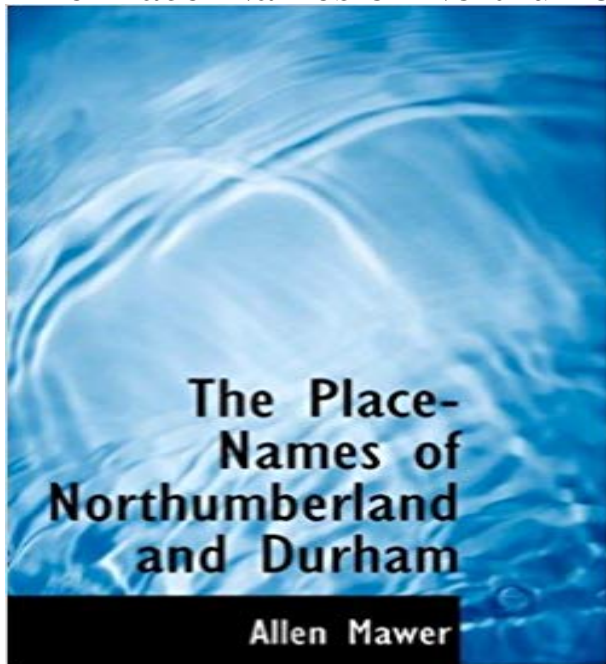


## The Place-Names of Northumberland and Durham
