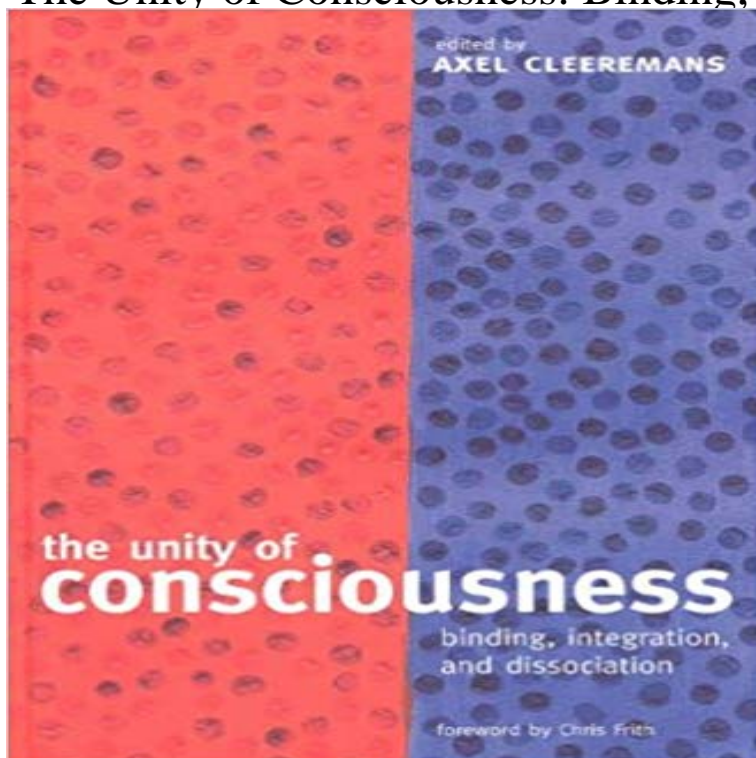


The Unity of Consciousness: Binding, Integration, and Dissociation
