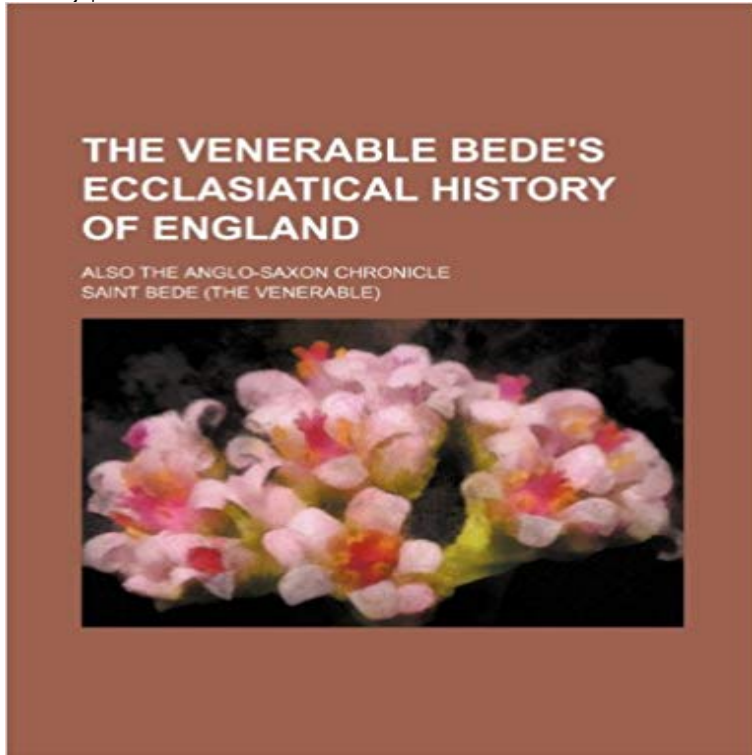


# The Venerable Bede's ecclesiastical history of England; Also the Anglo-Saxon chronicle
