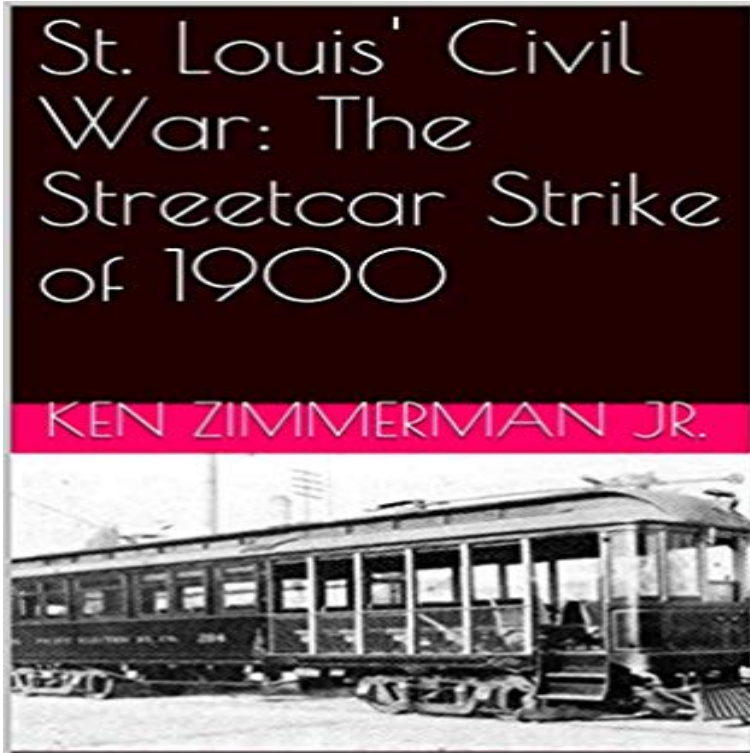


## St. Louis Civil War: The Streetcar Strike of 1900



On Saturday, May 5, 1900 at 11:30 p.m., the explosion of the Suburban Line at the Wabash and Sarah Street railroad crossing marked the beginning of the St. Louis Street Car Strike of 1900. Before the strike was over in September 1900, the streets of St. Louis would be a battleground between rich and poor with the St. Louis Police Department in the middle of the fray. The strike would divide the overwhelmed police department as well as the city itself. Before the strike effectively ended on September 11, 1900, 14 people including a St. Louis Police Officer were killed and hundreds were injured. Was it worth the sacrifice?
