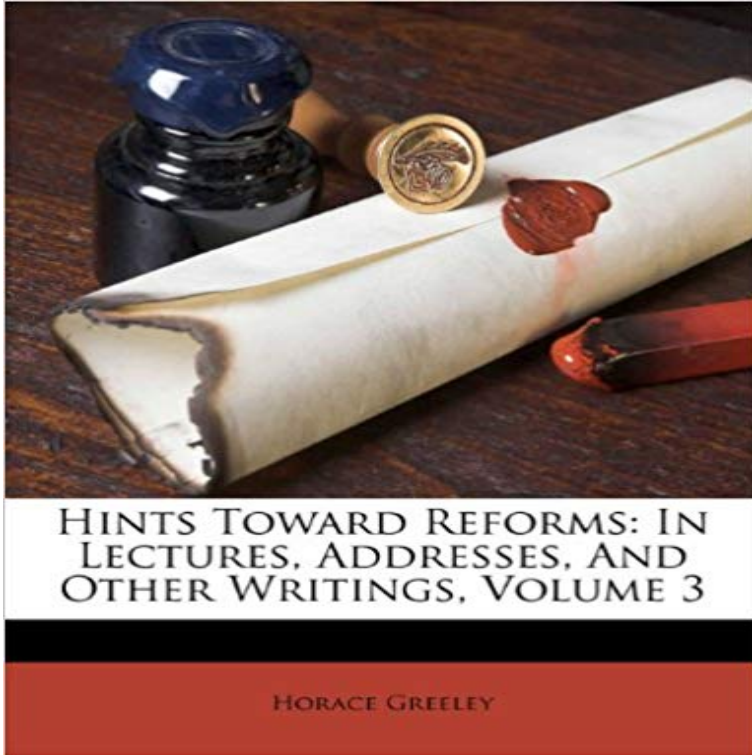


# Hints Toward Reforms: In Lectures, Addresses, And Other Writings, Volume 3
