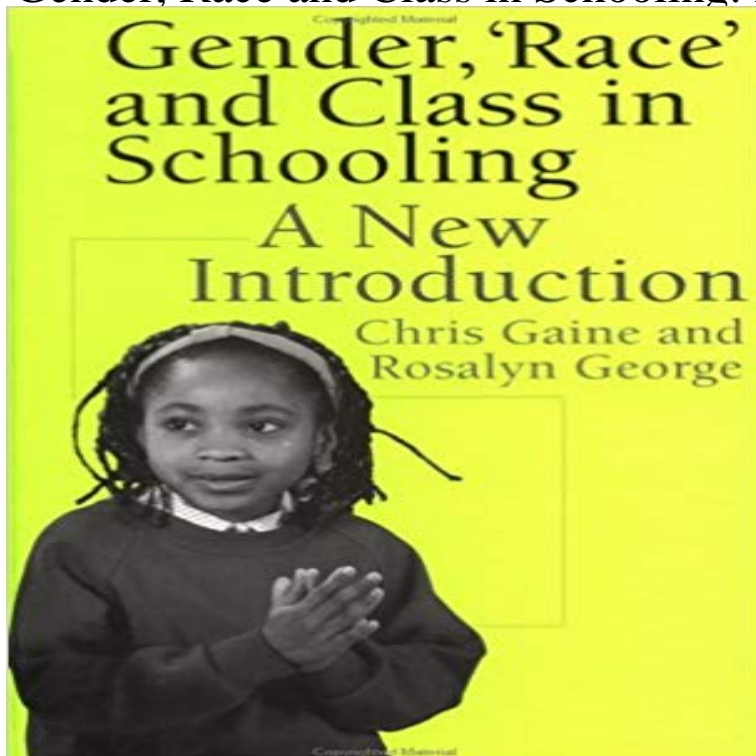


## Gender, Race and Class in Schooling: A New Introduction
